The 8th Annual Paradise on Ice Winter Wonderland Opens November 11th, 2021 through January 17th, 2022

Paradise, CA, November 3, 2021, - The Paradise Recreation and Park District (District, PRPD) announced the scheduled opening of the Paradise on Ice Rink for November 11, 2021 at the Terry Ashe Recreation Center in Paradise. To help celebrate the Veteran's Day holiday, the rink will open at 12:00 noon with free skating for active and retired military with ID.

In addition to the ice rink, the District is hosting a Winter Wonderland experience for the whole family with festive holiday lights, music and fun. While there will be a variety of events, the major ones include:

- On Saturday November 13th the District will host a cornhole tournament, chili cookoff, craft beer garden, and live music.
- Saturday November 27th is a free skating day thanks to Courtesy Motors Subaru. The day features live music, Pinewood Derby races for children and adults, a craft brew garden, as well as a Subaru-centric and classic car show.
- Saturday December 4th starts the countdown to Christmas with a Santa's Workshop holiday craft faire, live music, community-craft-an-ornament day, tree lighting and Santa's arrival.
- Music fans will be pleased to learn that the Yule Logs will be performing twice at the Terry Ashe Recreation Center on December 11th and 18th.

The Winter Wonderland event series culminates with a Polar Bear Paddlefest at Paradise Lake on Saturday January 8th. Rain and windy weather may cancel ice skating, but some events may continue, please check with the District office (530-872-6393) or website (www.paradisepprd.com) for the latest.
