Paradise Recreation and Park District POLICY CONCERNING DOGS IN THE PARKS

The Paradise Recreation and Park District Board of Directors at their regular meeting on February 14, 2006 approved the following policy concerning dogs at the District's facilities:

- No dogs allowed at Aquatic Park and the Terry Ashe Recreation Center.
- No dogs allowed in public buildings, tennis courts, playfields, playgrounds, or other posted restricted areas.
- Dogs will be allowed under compliance of these rules in designated areas as follows:
 - o Bille Park:

Dogs are allowed on a leash on the dog trail on the east side of Bille Park. This trail extends from the Bille Park shop at the east end of the Bille Park parking lot to the point overlooking Little Butte Creek Canyon.

- o Moore Road Park:
 - Dogs are allowed on a leash at Moore Road Park in the area between the ball parks and the Memorial Trailway. This dog area may be accessed from the lower gravel parking lot that lies between Moore Road and the District's Horse Arena. Dogs are not allowed on the playing fields.
- Ocutolenc Park, Concow Park, and Crain Park:
 Dogs are allowed on a leash at these locations. All County and/or Town ordinances apply.
- Exceptions to these rules will be under the authorization of the District Manager of the Paradise Recreation and Park District for special events, programs, or unique circumstances.
- Service dogs as defined under the law are allowed at all facilities.
